


September 1, 1953 - December 30, 2018



Daniel Lewis Johnson, 65, of E. Chapman RD, Carlsbad, NM, passed away on Sunday, December 30, 2018 at his home. Daniel L. Johnson was born September 1, 1953 in Bowman, SC. He was preceded in death by his loving parents, the late Harvey and Mary Inell Richardson Johnson.

Daniel's early childhood and secondary school education was in the Orangeburg, County School System. He earned his high school diploma and graduated from Bethune Memorial High School, Bowman, South Carolina.

He was also a member of the local Elks Lodge, and a member of the Carlsbad, New Mexico Downtown Lions Club, and the Hall of Fame Board for the city of Carlsbad as an appointee of Mayor Dale Janway. Daniel was a compassionate and caring gentleman who was always ready to lend a hand. He enjoyed golf as a pastime, and became quite astute as a golfer. Daniel will be sorely missed by many, both children and adults alike.
