

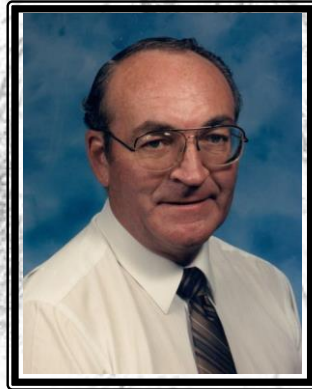


# IN MEMORIAM
